Smart Mobile

Overview

- Smart Mobile is a portable breath alcohol testing instrument with built-in camera and cellular modem. Smart Mobile is designed
 to monitor alcohol remotely.
- Smart Mobile can be programmed to require up to 10 tests per day within time frames referred to as 'test windows'. Test windows can be varied from one day to another.
- Tests can either be 'scheduled' or 'random'.
- With a scheduled test, the Smart Mobile calls for a test at a scheduled time.
- With a random test, the Smart Mobile calls for a test randomly within a test window. A random test helps prevent strategic drinking to avoid test windows.
- The minimum duration of a test window is 15 minutes (30 minutes if random). At the other end of the scale the absolute maximum is 24 hours, although in practice test windows are usually restricted to waking hours.
- Smart Mobile uses facial detection and photo ID. A digital image of the user is captured and stored every time a test is taken. This provides a record which can be used to confirm identity in relation to any and every test. Photos can be included in reports provided to persons or agencies involved in monitoring a user's compliance with testing requirements.
- Once a scheduled or random test has been successfully completed, any new data is uploaded to Smart Start's database server
 via the device's onboard cellular modem. If a cellular signal is not available, Smart Mobile stores the data until a communication
 link can be established and a data upload successfully completed.
- If a user fails to successfully complete a breath test before a test window closes, the event will be recorded as either a skipped or failed (>0.02 BAC) test. Upon request, this can trigger a violation notification sent to monitoring authorities within minutes of the event.





Cost

- Smart Mobile costs \$299.00 per month. This price is all inclusive with no additional fees. It covers any and all test windows (regardless of the number or whether they are scheduled or random) plus any changes to test windows that may be requested.
- Smart Mobile does not have a minimum lease requirement.
